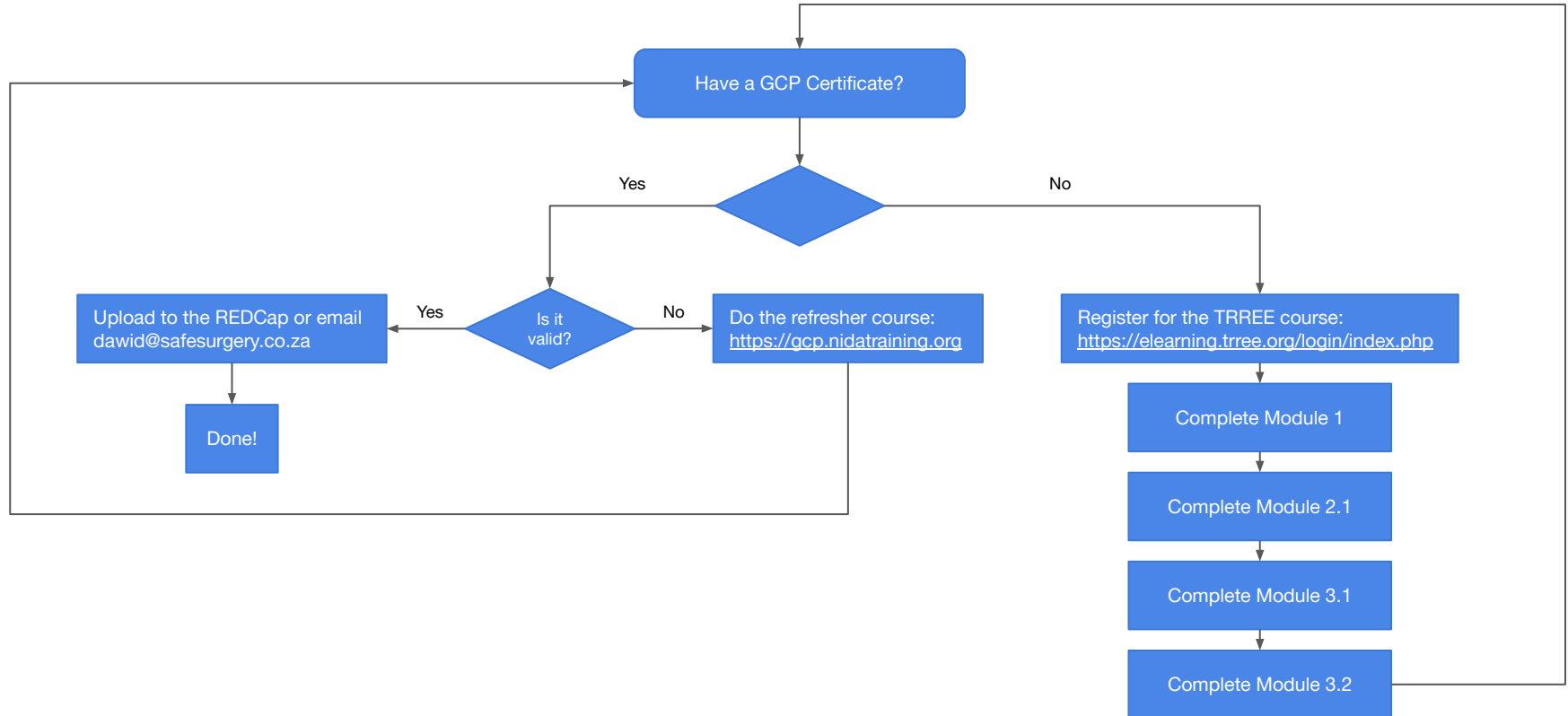
The ASOS-2 Trial is about **more** than just assessing whether increased postoperative surveillance decreases major morbidity and mortality in African surgical patients identified at high-risk of postoperative morbidity and mortality through the ASOS Surgical Risk Prediction calculator.

The ASOS-2 Trial is also about **building research capacity and developing a research culture in Africa!**

Why do I need a GCP Certificate?

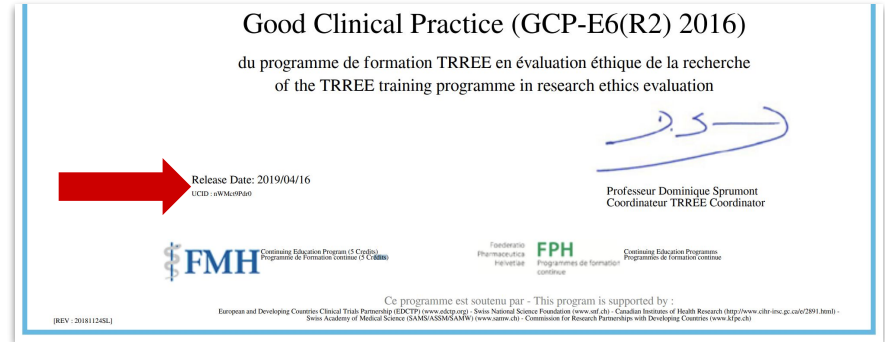
Good Clinical Practice is a standard of practice ensuring that all clinical research are conducted ethically. All international and scientific studies need to comply with GCP in order to ensure that the rights, safety as well as the wellbeing of all participants are protected. The GCP also assures the reliability of the data.

Already have a valid GCP Certificate?

- If you already have a GCP certificate please ensure that it is still **valid**. A GCP certificate generally **expires 3 years from the date it was issued**.
- If your GCP certificate is valid, upload the GCP certificate to the registration form which asks you to upload the GCP certificate or email your GCP certificate to dawid@safesurgery.co.za



Expired GCP Certificate?

If your GCP certificate have **expired**. Please make use of the **National Drug Abuse Treatment Clinical Trials Network** GCP link (<https://gcp.nidatraining.org/>) to do a **GCP refresher course**. 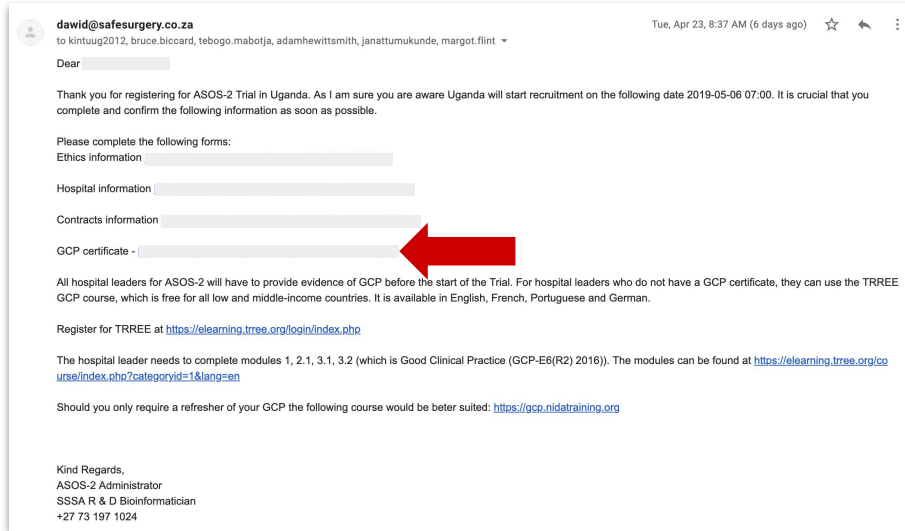
